

MIT Annual Fund | MIT 24-Hour Challenge Drone Sweepstakes Rules

NO DONATION NECESSARY TO ENTER. Donation does not increase the chances of winning. All sweepstakes begin at 12:01 AM ET on March 14, 2018. [Deadlines for entry for each sweepstakes vary as specified below.] All times referenced are Eastern Time. Void where prohibited. Open only to legal residents of the U.S. (including the District of Columbia; excluding Rhode Island), and Canada, 18 or older.

A donation in any amount within these deadlines coupled with a photo of entrant's "MIT collaborator" posted on Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram using the hashtag MIT24 results in an automatic entry. Subject to applicable sweepstakes rules.

To enter the sweepstakes without a pledge, send an email to annual_fund@mit.edu and submit your contact information or send a 3x5 card with full name, address, phone number, and email address to MIT Annual Fund, 600 Memorial Drive, W98-1st Floor, Cambridge, MA 02139. One entry per person. All entries must be complete to be eligible. All online entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. ET on Wednesday, March 14. Mailed entries must be postmarked by Wednesday, March 14, 2018. Once submitted, entries become the sole property of the MIT Annual Fund and will not be returned.

This sweepstakes is governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. By entering sweepstakes, entrant consents to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts located in Middlesex County, Massachusetts for resolution of all disputes.

Winner(s) will be selected in a random drawing approximately one month after the end of the fundraiser. Once submitted, entries become the sole property of the MIT Annual Fund and will not be returned. Winners will be notified by phone, mail and/or email. If potential winner cannot be reached after 10 days from first notification attempt, or if an entrant is found to be ineligible, or prize notification is returned as undeliverable, such prize will be forfeited. Entrants need not be present to win. In the event the winner declines the prize, another winner will be selected. In the event the second winner declines the prize, the prize may be designated for another sweepstakes or fundraising auction.

Persons affiliated with MIT are ineligible to win. Winner may be required to sign an affidavit of eligibility and a receipt. Winner may be required to sign an acknowledgment and general release of claims and a W9 form. No substitution will be allowed and prizes may not be redeemed for cash or other consideration. The MIT Annual Fund is not responsible or liable for multiple entries completed or entered by other than human means or entries that are late (including delayed data transmissions), tampered with, illegible, mutilated, forged, destroyed, incomplete, garbled, lost, misdirected, mechanically duplicated, mass machine

printed, postage-due, or otherwise not in compliance with the MIT Annual Fund Sweepstakes Rules and Regulations (and such entries will be disqualified). Sweepstakes prizes and deadlines are as follows:

(a) Prize is one (1) DJI Phantom 4 Quadcopter. A total of three (3) winners will be selected. Each winner will receive the prize mailed to the U.S. or Canada address of their choosing. Mailing address must be provided by May 30, 2018. Winner is responsible for payment of all tax obligations. Optional insurance, expedited mailing, and any other add-ons are not included and must be paid for by the prize-winners. The MIT Annual Fund reserves the right to substitute the prize for one of equal or greater value if the designated prize should become unavailable for any reason. Should the winner cancel after accepting the prize, the prize is forfeited and no substitution or credit will be provided. If the actual value of the prize turns out to be less than the stated value, the difference will not be awarded in cash. Total value for each prize is up to \$1,100 [sticker price \$1,199, price paid \$929]. Deadline to enter is on Wednesday, March 14, 2018, at 11:59 PM.

All entries must be postmarked by deadlines listed above or emailed to annual_fund@mit.edu. Sweepstakes deadlines subject to be extended. Dates, times, deadlines, price, and prizes subject to change. Estimated odds of winning are determined by the number of entries received.
